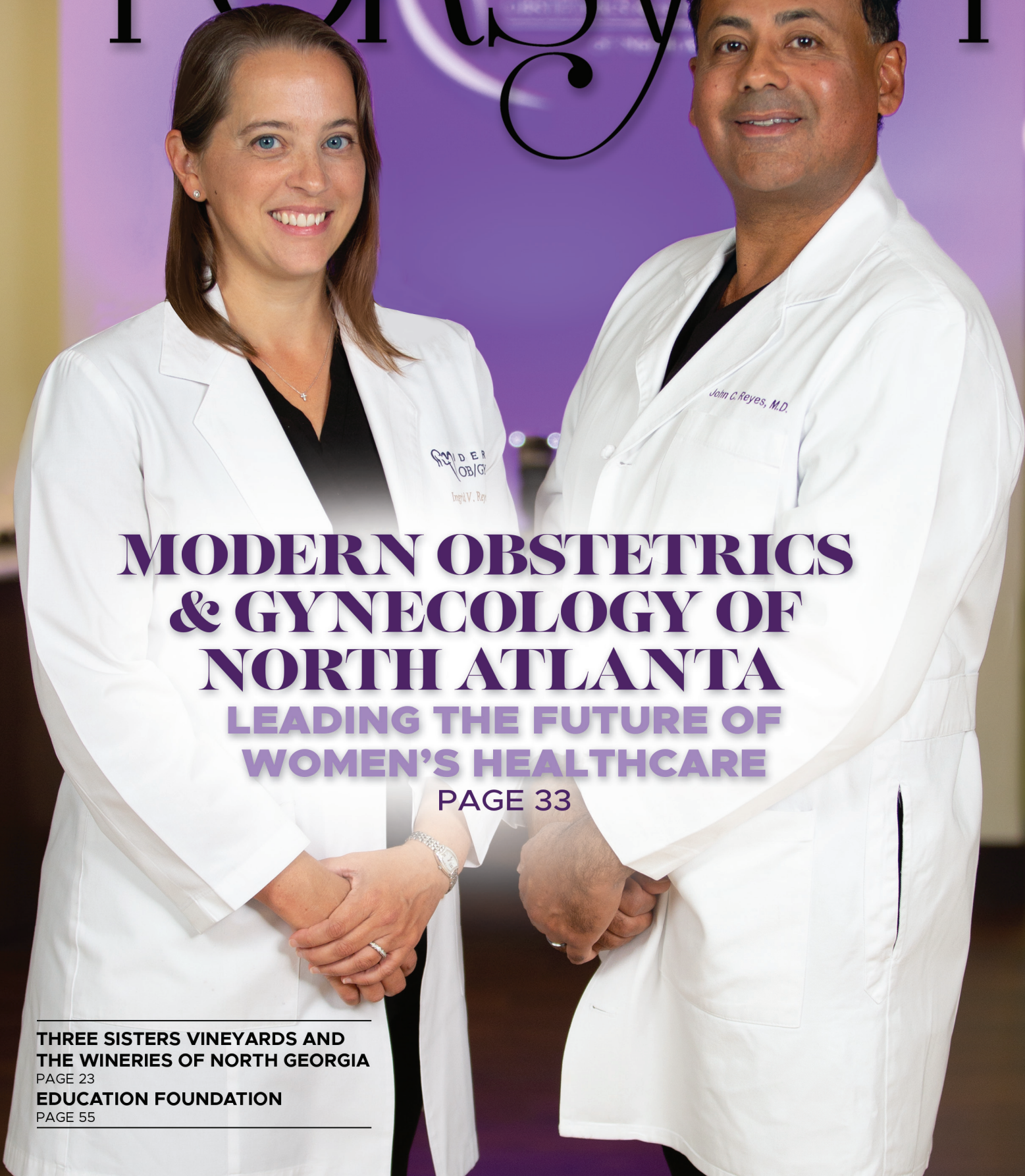

As one of the areas few practices using the da Vinci® robotic surgical system, the surgeons at Modern OB/GYN are able to provide their patients with groundbreaking alternatives to both traditional open surgery and conventional laparoscopy. The use of the da Vinci® system allows surgeons of Modern OB/GYN to perform hysterectomies and other surgeries through only a few small incisions. Most patients can expect to return to their usual activities within a couple of weeks of surgery.

“In-office procedures in our surgical suite are a safe and excellent option for many patients. It’s great to be able to offer these procedures to women because they can get back to their lives so quickly, oftentimes even the same day. 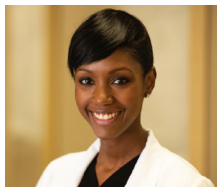
JOHN REYES, M.D., F.A.C.O.G.
